Methods for verifying learning outcomes and assessment criteria

Learning outcomes presented above are verified as follows:

Written exam covering the presented program content.

Programme content

1. Social psychology - subject, structure and methods. Main trends and schools in social psychology. Man in a social organization - the behavior of individuals in the social context. Group and behavior. Interactions. Concepts of man and personality - types of personality. Socialization, its determinants and psychosocial role - mechanisms of adaptation and maladjustment. Needs, motivations and attitudes. Attitudes - the mechanism of formation and structure. Attitude functions - adaptive, ego defense, value expression, cognitive. Social roles and their influence on attitudes and behavior. Mechanisms of attitude change - the theory of cognitive dissonance. Psychosocial determinants of decisions. Psychotechnics and social engineering and psychomanipulation. Management and leadership - theories of leadership styles. Psychological aspects of organization and human team control. Social deviations and pathologies.

Teaching methods

Informative (conventional) lecture (providing information in a structured way) - may be of a course (introductory) or monographic (specialist) character

Seminar lecture ("external dialogue" between the lecturer and the student; students participate in solving the problem)
