

Application Requirements

Application Materials Required (Softcopy, for all departments)

- 1. Head shot photo (JPG, <5mb)
- 2. Official Enrollment Certificate (PDF, <5mb)
- 3. Latest official transcript in English (PDF, <5mb) .
- 4. Autobiography (PDF, <5mb)
- *An autobiography could be a combination of a short statement about yourself and your resume. It is preferable to have a focus on your academic path.
- 5. Study plan for the exchange period (PDF, <5mb, preferably including your course list)



- 6. Recommendation letters (PDF, <5mb, at least 2, dated with signatures of the sponsors.)
- *The documents should include the sponsors' names and titles in print.
- 7. Financial statement issued by a bank/financial institution (PDF, <5mb)
- *A financial statement is to verify that the student has at least NT\$100,000 available for one academic year, or NT\$50,000 for one academic semester to support his/her exchange period financially.
- 8. Passport's information page (PDF, <5mb)
- 9. Photo ID, both sides (PDF, <5mb, Required for Chinese nationality only)
- 10. Certificate(s) of Chinese language or English language proficiency (PDF, <5mb, optional)
- 11. **Other supporting documents_**(PDF, <30mb, optional. Applicants, who are required to provide their portfolios, should submit the files here.)
- 12. Confirmation Page (PDF, <5mb)

Students can download and print this document from the application portal AFTER they complete the requirement of the portal. The <u>Confirmation Page</u> has to be proofed and signed by the applicant, and then to be signed by his/her exchange coordinator of home university (fee-paying students can skip the coordinators' signature). When finished, a scanned copy of this document should be uploaded to the portal to complete the application. If you find any errors on your <u>Confirmation Page</u> printout, you may mark the error(s) on the paper before you submit it online. In this case, please inform us through email about the error(s) of your application.

*All materials shall be prepared in the form of <u>clear & colored scanned copy</u> of the originals and be submitted to NCKU Online Application. <u>No mailing of the original documents is required</u>.

Application procedure

1.Nomination	Coordinators of partner Universities kindly fill out the nomination
	sheet online (url to be provided through email) by
	April 1, for the fall entrance; October 15, for the spring entrance.
2. NCKU online application	Nominee(s) shall complete their application at NCKU online
	application by the due date. The online application URL will be
	available from OIA of the home universities.
	Fee-paying exchange students will need to email the program
	coordinator, Ms. Weili Teng, at em50961@email.ncku.edu.tw for
	access to NCKU online application.
3.Annoncement of Acceptance	It will be available 6-8 weeks after the application closes.

Accommodation

On-campus housing	After applications are accepted by NCKU, applicants will be
	prompted by email to sign up for on-campus accommodation
	online. Please note that space of the on-campus accommodation is
	not guaranteed, and students will be responsible for their own
	housing expenses, unless specified differently in an agreement. To
	have a quick review of NCKU on-campus dormitory designated to
	exchange students, please take a look at Ching 3 Dorm, which
	offers double rooms to international students.
Off-campus housing	OIA provides advice on finding off-campus accommodation upon
	request. Students may consider Prince Hall, which exclusively
	serves NCKU students. Single rooms are available. Students will
	have to apply by themselves, as it is managed by a private sector.

Cost of study and living estimates

Tuition Fees	In accordance with bilateral student exchange agreements, an
	exchange student, with nomination, needs to pay tuition fees to
	his/her home university and does not have to pay tuition at the host
	university. Students, who apply with no nomination, or are from
4	universities that have no student exchange agreement with NCKU,
	will need to pay tuition fees to NCKU as a foreign student. Please
	click the tuition schedule for detail.
Cost of Housing	Ching 3 Dorm: NT\$13,700 per semester(subject to change)
	Off-campus: NT\$3500-\$8500 per month
Living Cost	Meals and other expenses in total range from \$6,000 to \$10,000
	NTD per month, depending on individual lifestyle.



Health Insurance

Mandatory NCKU student group	Each student is required to join in NCKU student group insurance at
insurance	around NT\$200 for one semester upon registration.
Private overseas insurance	All exchange students need to purchase their own overseas
	insurance, which includes health and accident coverage for the
	exchange period, in their home country before departure. A copy of
	valid insurance summary is required for registration at NCKU.

Type B Health Certificate(optional)

All exchange students are required to submit a NCKU Student Health Check Form plus Health Certificate for Short-Term Students ,the proof of positive measles and rubella antibody titers or measles and rubella vaccination certificates and chest X-Ray for Tuberculosis record for university enrollment. You may get the exam done in your home country and ask the doctor to fill out and sign the Health Certificate for Short-Term Students, then submit the proofs on the registration day. If you couldn't complete the health exam in your home country, you can take the exam at NCKU Hospital when you are in Taiwan and send the copy to ISAD at (em50990@email.ncku.edu.tw), OIA after receiving your report.

If you do not have the measles, rubella vaccination certificates and the chest X-Ray for Tuberculosis record with you, you must take the vaccines and the Chest X ray exam at NCKU hospital or a private clinic. After you submit the vaccination and the chest X-Ray record to NCKU hospital, you can complete the health check-up. Kindly note that you will be charged extra fees for measles, rubella vaccination and chest X-Ray exam.

Visitor visa holders (only for one-year exchange students, with annotation "FS" followed by the name of the university or "FR" followed by the Chinese language center) must apply for a resident visa after enrolling. To apply for a resident visa in Taiwan, it is necessary to have a Health Certificate (Type B Health Certificate) issued by an authorized hospital in Taiwan.

Visa

Visitor visa	Students admitted by an exchange student program must apply for
	a Taiwan (ROC <u>) visitor visa</u> with annotation "FS" followed by the
	name of the host university, prior to entering Taiwan. When

	necessary, students may apply for a visa extension in Taiwan.
	Please be advised not to enter the country with a landing
	visa, which may not be extended. More information may be
	found at Bureau of Consular Affairs (<u>BOCA</u>)
	PRC nationals need to obtain a special type of visa, Taiwan Entry
	Permit to enter Taiwan. NCKU will apply on behalf of Chinese
	students after acceptance.
	Hong Kong or Macau residents, holding Hong Kong or Macau IDs
	may apply for Taiwan Entry Permit on their own at <u>Taipei and</u>
	Economic Office (HK).
	Students will be responsible for all visa-related fees.
Resident Visa	Exchange students, who will stay for two semesters and hold
	ordinary passports or other legal travel documents, may apply for a
	resident visa.
