APPLICATION PROCESS

Application Requirements for International Students	<p>International students must enter to the following link (Postulación 2020) and submit the following documents to complete their applications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🔴 Presentation letter from their home university: stating semesters the student will be studying at UPC, academic program they are currently enrolled in at their home institution.* 🔴 Official academic transcripts. 🔴 01 photo with white background, facing forward, jpeg extension, like a passport photo.* 🔴 Passport copy.* 🔴 Round trip flight tickets.* 🔴 Non-refundable international health insurance policy with coverage in Peru.* 🔴 Letter of Economic Solvency filled out by their parents.* 🔴 UPC course application form. <p>* Mandatory documents for Visa processing. <u>Note:</u> International applicants should be nominated by their home institution</p>
UPC Acceptance Letter	<p>After receiving the student's application, the admission committee will review the documents and the Letter of Acceptance will be sent by email. The process may take a couple of weeks.</p>

VISAS

Student academic visas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 🔴 Visas for students will be requested by UPC, only if the student documents are complete. 🔴 The files will be processed by the Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. 🔴 The process may take 30 to 45 business days. 🔴 The Peruvian Ministry of Foreign Affairs will issue a cable number per student, which UPC will send via email to the home university. 🔴 Students should contact the Peruvian Consulate that they indicated and confirm the documents they must submit to collect their visa. 🔴 The cost of the visa varies according to each country and is paid directly at the Peruvian Consulate. 🔴 If documents are sent after the application deadline or they are not sent correctly, UPC will not be responsible for issuing the student visa, nor for the process of change of migratory quality or extension of days in the country.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Language of instruction	Spanish, English (courses upon request)
English courses	UPC's English course catalogue can vary every semester. The list of English courses provided by UPC will be provided based on request.
Course information	Course syllabi will be sent via e-mail to applicants. Applicants must indicate the UPC program, course name and UPC code.
Minimum courses international students should be enrolled in	1 course (aprox. 3 credits)
Official Transcripts – UPC	UPC will issue official academic transcripts roughly one month after the end of classes. Official academic transcripts will be sent via e-mail in digital format to the International Office of the foreign institution.
Language Requirements	Intermediate Spanish (B1)
Grading Scale	Grading scale in Peru runs from 0 to 20, 20 being the maximum score. Passing grade in Peru is set at 11 but at UPC it has been set at 13 to ensure academic exigency.



Credits	At UPC, courses usually are worth 3 to 4 credits. Rough conversion to ECTS: 1 UPC credit = 2 ECTS.
Changes to course schedules	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Once the online course registration process is completed, students will not be able to make changes to their courses.Learning agreements sent after that date will be evaluated and possibly rejected.
